A Remembrance of the Suffering and Hardships Endured by the People of West Bengal During the Period of Partition and Independence

Report

Shukla Devi Academy for B.Ed. & D.Ed. organized a **Day of Remembrance of the Partition of Bengal** on **14th August 2026 at 12:30 PM** in the **College Seminar Room**. The programme was held to remember the painful experiences, sacrifices, suffering and hardships endured by the people of West Bengal during the period of Partition and Independence.

The programme began with a respectful tribute to the countless people whose lives were deeply affected by the Partition of Bengal. The event provided an opportunity for students and teachers to reflect on one of the most difficult chapters in the history of Bengal and to understand the human cost of political division.

The speakers highlighted the experiences of families who were forced to leave their homes, migrate across newly created borders and rebuild their lives under extremely difficult circumstances. Many people faced displacement, loss of property, separation from loved ones, insecurity and uncertainty. The hardships experienced by refugees and their contribution to rebuilding their lives and communities were also remembered.

The programme emphasized that remembrance is not intended to create division or bitterness. Rather, it is an opportunity to honour the resilience of those who suffered and to promote peace, harmony, compassion and mutual respect among communities. The younger generation was encouraged to learn from history and to value unity, humanity and peaceful coexistence.

Students participated with sincerity and respect, making the programme meaningful and reflective. Through speeches, discussions and remembrance activities, the event helped create greater awareness of the historical experiences associated with Partition and Independence.

The programme concluded with a message that the memories of those who suffered should be preserved with dignity and that future generations should work towards a society based on **peace, unity, tolerance and humanity**.

The Day of Remembrance served as a meaningful tribute to the victims and survivors of Partition and as a reminder of the importance of learning from history to build a more peaceful future.

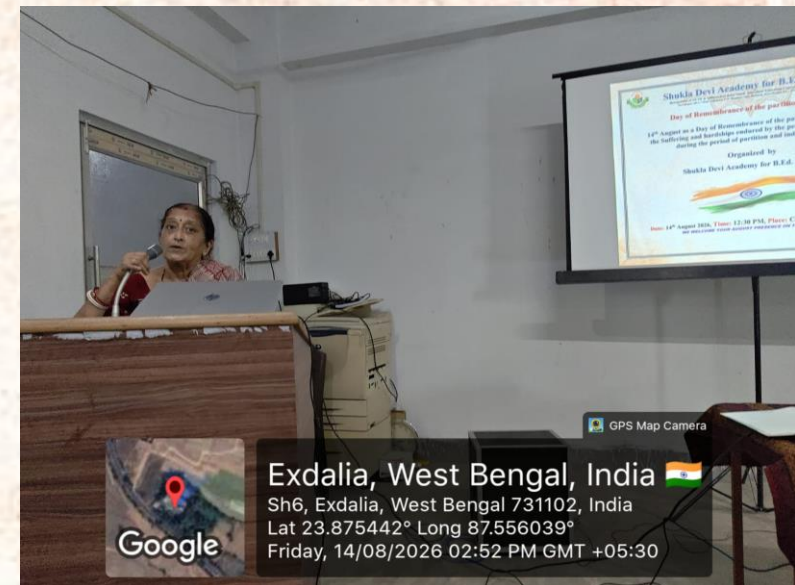
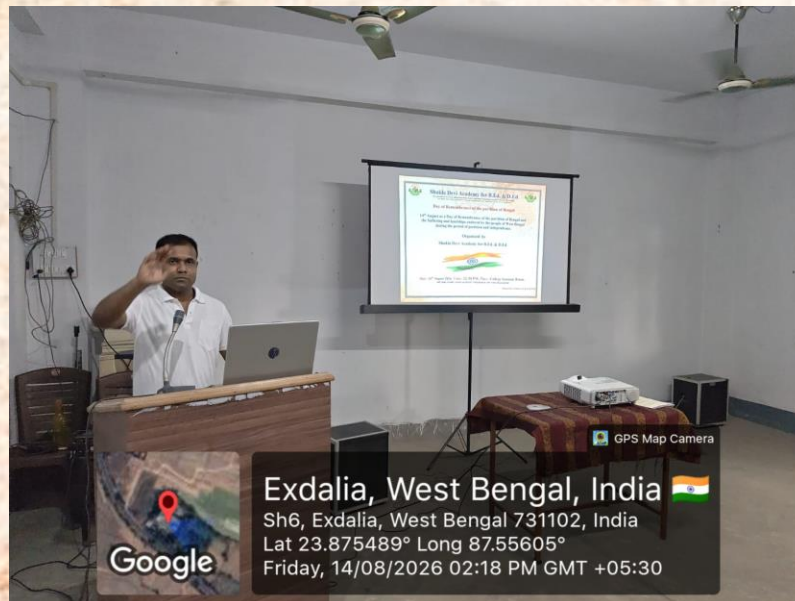
